

## Plain Statements in the Bible on God's Character

1. Gen. 1:31 – Everything God made was very good.
2. Gen. 15:6 – Abraham trusted God and God considered it his righteousness.
3. Exod. 34:6, 7 – God's character is love.
4. Isaiah 40:10-11 – God is strong and gentle.
5. Isaiah 42:1-9 – God's Servant is gentle and kind.
6. Isaiah 49:15, 16 – A woman may forget her child, but I will not forget you.
7. Isaiah 55:6-9 – God abundantly pardons because His thoughts are higher than ours.
8. Isaiah 57:14-15 – God lives in the high and holy place and also with those of contrite heart.
9. Ezekiel 18:19, 20 – No one should suffer for another's sins.
10. Ezekiel 18:23, 30-31; 33:11 – God has no pleasure in the death of the wicked.
11. Hosea 2:14-20 – God is not an owner-husband, but a companion-husband.
12. Hosea 11:1-9 – God cries out, "How can I give you up?"
13. Micah 6:8 – God wants us to do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with Him.
14. Micah 7:18-20 – God delights in forgiving us.

1. 1 John 4:8-10, 16-19 – God is love; love comes from God.
2. 1 Cor. 13:4-8 – What is love?
3. John 1:1-3, 14, 18 – Jesus is the revelation of the Father.
4. John 10:10-18 – Jesus is the good Shepherd who comes to save, not to destroy.
4. John 14:9 – Those who have seen Jesus have seen the Father.
5. John 16:25-27 – Jesus will not pray the Father for us because the Father loves us Himself.
6. John 17:3 – Eternal life is knowing God and Jesus.
7. John 17:4 – Jesus finished His work on earth by glorifying the Father.
8. Rom. 3:28, 31; 4:5 – righteousness through trust
9. Rom. 6:20-23 – sin leads to death; the wages of sin is death.
10. Rom. 8:14-15, 26, 27, 31-39 – All three Members of the Godhead love us and nothing can separate us from that love.
